

# From Previous Tech Talk

### **COVID** and Health Policy

As a new strain of Covid-19, Omicron is still an issue, and we are all concern about the safety of our students and ourselves. Our school will continue testing students for the Covid-19 and will report all positive tests to parents and caregivers on a regular basis. The BTHS Health and Safety team, indicated that all students will be given 2 Covid-19 self-test kits each week. All students whether vaccinated or not and exhibit any sign of illness must remain at home and use the test kit. In addition, if you want your child to be tested in school, please fill out the online permission form on the DOE web site. Without your permission the school cannot test your child.

All positive tests by a medical center or a Covid-19 testing site or self-tested must be reported to the school, so contact tracing can be enabled. To report your finding please email your results to **ReportCOVID@bths.edu**.

Our new School Chancellor, David Banks, has sent a **recent family letter** on January 5<sup>th</sup> welcoming students back into the new school year. In his letter, he encourages families to get tested for COVID-19, get vaccinated and to consent to in-school testing. Chancellor Bank also sent a family letter regarding school-based testing **here** dated January 3rd. Please read the service update entirely and understand the New Quarantine Policy.

BTHS's Health and Safety Team also sent families an email about procedures on how to report positive COVID cases within the school communities. For those who might have missed the email, please see **here**. Per school's website, students should email teachers to request Asynchronous Work/Office Hours for those who tested positive for COVID.

As per the DOE health policy, asynchronous instruction is provided to students who test positive for COVID. Students should email teachers if they have tested positive and need asynchronous instructions. Asynchronous remote instruction is not an option for those who choose to self-isolate or have been in close contact/live with someone who has COVID. Your child will be marked absent for the days they are out.
