

# Highlights from recent BTHS PA events <u>December PA Workshops Resources</u>

- **PA Co- Presidents** shared that based on feedback received, teachers and Tech staff will receive Seamless e-gift cards as appreciation in lieu of the annual PTC Fall dinner that was traditionally held; conferences were held remotely this year due to Covid-19.
- PA Diversity & Community Engagement Committee Update Emails with detailed information on the events will be sent out. Volunteers (parents and students) are needed for the dance and the Talent Showcase. Parents are asked to sign up for the BTHS PA's new <a href="YouTube channel">YouTube channel</a> as it needs to have at least 100 subscribers. There is also an upcoming book club meeting. - PA Events and Volunteers Update Four different workshops were held last weekend on Naviance, DDP, College and Navigating BTHS for Freshman. More workshops are being planned focusing on topics such as college readiness and other topics.
- PA Communications Committee Update Parents are encouraged to sign up to receive Tech Talk, the PA newsletters. Parents are also invited to connect with the BTHS PA on different social media platforms and to volunteer to help with keeping them updated. Volunteers are also welcome to help us translate Tech Talk into additional languages.

**Social Emotional Support Services - AP Johnny Ventura -** spoke about the Social Emotional Support surveys that were sent to students and parents. He mentioned that they would like for many more parents to complete the survey so that the school can make the needed services available during this difficult time. He introduced staff members, Kathryn Lyng and Social Worker, Christina Martinez and discussed the support they will be providing to the students. The PA will send the **survey** out again so that more parents can respond. Parents suggested the idea of including Advisory for all grades.

**Principal's Report - David Newman -** On December 23, 2020 all classes will meet but for shorter times and SEL sessions. Lots of activities are planned and if it works, we will do it periodically. The school's calendar shows the dates for finals. The PSAT will be on January 26th if we are in the building, otherwise it will be canceled. The school is looking to consolidate cohorts so the students who are hybrid will get an opportunity to be in the building more provided the school can do this safely.
