

Most Commonly Applied to Colleges/Universities at BTHS

Below are some sample admissions statistics comparing nation-wide and BTHS local acceptance rates at popular colleges and universities. As you will see, some colleges are overrepresented with BTHS applicants (i.e. they receive disproportionately high numbers of BTHS applicants) and therefore have lower 'local' acceptance rates than national average – e.g. Barnard College.

Other colleges are underrepresented with BTHS applicants (i.e. they receive disproportionately low numbers of BTHS applicants) and therefore have higher 'local' acceptance rates than national average – e.g. Mount Holyoke College.

Colleges that disproportionately waitlist BTHS applicants are marked with an asterisk. As colleges and universities try to increase their yield numbers (i.e. the number of accepted students who actually enroll), some strategically waitlist students who meet their academic criteria but are deemed unlikely to attend. It would be advisable to visit these colleges in person or otherwise show demonstrated interest (e.g. alumni interviews) – or both!
