June 18, 2020 Diversity Committee Meeting Notes

A group of about two dozen parents and students met via videoconference on the evening of June 18 to discuss ways the PA might be able to support inclusiveness and appreciation of diversity in the Tech Community.

Some ideas were suggested to promote greater inter-racial good will among students and staff, including: forming a joint PA / Equity Team book club (the Equity Team is a group of teachers who are studying social bias issues at Tech), advocating for a required core course for all freshman students that would augment the DOE's Culturally Responsive Sustaining Education initiative and offering educational and training workshops for parents and students, among others.

It was also suggested that the school should step up efforts to train and encourage teachers to intervene in student interactions involving hate speech.

1) BTHS Library Summer Passion Project


With the lack of summer jobs, internships, and other opportunities in 2020, students are looking for ways to learn and expand their experiences while at home. An independent passion project (aka 20% time project) is a great way to take advantage of this time to delve into personal interests and it also shows student initiative. Projects that involve research and learning can be shared with teachers who write recommendation letters, be incorporated into college essays, and included on college applications.

The Summer Passion Project involves a student (or a group of students) developing their own project and learning about something they are passionate about, but also sharing the learning in a way that could be useful or potentially useful.

Students: Follow your own desires to learn and reach out. Mix and match what you would like to do: make games, websites, videos, Ted Talks, design, art, etc. with your interests: children, elderly, equity, politics, health, environment, science, English Language Learners, etc. The project you design must include time spent learning through books, research articles, interviews, testing, etc. Project goals and outlines are due by 7/10 and evidence of completion by 8/25 for a certificate. Thanks to Mr. Malchiodi for all the Good News!

Students at Brooklyn Tech have surely been garnering accolades and winning awards since Tech was founded almost a century ago, but for the first 94 years, the Tech community was mostly left unaware of these accomplishments. Then venerable Brooklyn Tech English teacher Giancarlo Malchiodi stepped into the part-time role of Good News Coordinator. You have probably seen, and hopefully enjoyed, his bimonthly "Good News" letter detailing Tech students' achievements in sports, arts and letters and charitable work, as well as awards bestowed upon our distinguished faculty members that would otherwise escape our attention. In his own words, his mission was "To better inform ourselves about the special place we come to every day and all the good things that happen here so that a greater sense of community may be established...[and] To better educate the City-atlarge about all the good that happens or starts here so that our profile as a school is increased."

If you have not already seen it, take a look at the <u>latest issue here</u>. The issue features student achievements ranging from the winner of an environmental poetry contest to 3-D printing of PPE for a senior citizens home in Brooklyn. 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> Per <u>DOE's website</u>, the Chancellor reminded families to fill out the following surveys.

- 1) 2020 Census The Census is a headcount of the U.S. population that happens once every ten years. It is extremely important to fill out because it determines critical educational resources available to New York City, as well as other vital government benefits and electoral representation.
- 2) How to Vote for the June 23 Primary Election:
 - In-person voting, including early voting, is still available. You may do so during the early voting period from now until Sunday, June 21, or on Election Day, June 23. To find your early voting site, Election Day site, and poll site hours, visit visit here.
 - To register to vote in future elections, update your existing registration, find your assigned poll site, check your registration status, or get more information on voting visit here or call 3-1-1.
- 3) 2020 Return To School Survey BOE created a short, anonymous survey to help administrators to understand what is most important to parents and students in terms of considerations to return to school in the Fall of 2020. Parents or students should take the survey to voice your concerns about returning to school this fall. For those families who cannot take the online survey, they may call 3-1-1.

- AP Make Up Exams: The window for requesting a makeup exam has closed. If students have two makeup exams scheduled at the same time or are unable to take or complete the makeup exam, they'll be able to take one exam in the makeup testing period and the other in the final exception testing period in late June.
